Effective, December 16, 2019 the following timelines were established for voiding of a license:

• Probates/License Commissioners: 72 hours after purchase

• POS Agents: 24 hours after purchase

Licenses should be voided by the agent; however, if your allotted time has expired you may contact us at 334-242-3829 or 888-879-4150, ext. 0 and we will void the license. However, if the license contains a fulfillment privilege (hard cards, federal duck stamp) that has already shipped the license will be voided but you will not retain the credit.

Issues of untimely voiding of a license.....

- Applicants having the ability to reprint a license from the website because the license is still in an active status and utilize the privilege (hunting, fishing, etc.)
- The fulfillment process take place within 3-4 days after purchase, so when voids are not done timely the applicant will be mailed a hard card or federal duck stamp because the license is still in an active status.
- The monthly report totals are incorrect which causes manual adjustments if a license is not voided in the correct month.

Suggestions on how to ensure licenses are voided timely.....

- Make it a practice to <u>reconcile daily</u>, by running reports and balance them to your cash drawer.
- Educate your staff on the importance of voiding licenses as they occur which should be completed before generating another sale.
- Make sure that you verify information with the customer before completing the transaction (the address verification button should only be clicked after you have verified the address with the customer)
- Designate a specific person to perform the voiding process.
- Contact DCNR if needed.

Refunds

• Agents should rarely be issuing refunds back to a customer. Anything outside of the <u>original purchase date</u> should be referred to the License Section by calling 334-242-3829 and we will handle the refunding if needed. The summary page of the transaction should always be verified with the customer <u>before</u> completing the transaction and all customers should review their license purchase before leaving the counter for accuracy.

Physically Disabled Resident Licenses

- 1. Document must be dated within one year of the purchase date
- 2. Document must state that applicant is disabled, receiving or entitled to disability benefits or receiving SSI. A favorable response from Review and Adjudication will be accepted but must meet criteria #1.

For prior approval, fax your documents to us at 334-353-3208 or 334-242-3032 and include contact name and phone number for immediate response.

If document doesn't contain both criteria above, applicant should contact SSA (800-772-1213) and request a Benefits Verification Letter that includes the type of benefit.

Note:

You must have in hand the correct disability certification paperwork <u>before</u> issuance of the license. Customer must complete the required application which should be mailed to Montgomery along with disability certification and driver's license.

You cannot issue a Physically Disabled Resident License with paperwork from the VA.

Disabled Military Veteran's Appreciation Licenses

• Agent should review document from the VA and issue the privilege(s) based on the % of disability noted in the document.

For prior approval, fax your documents to us at 334-353-3208 or 334-242-3032 and include contact name and phone number for immediate response.

Note:

- 1. No application is required
- 2. No date compliant
- 3. No paperwork is mailed to Montgomery

Remember VETERAN APPRECIATION = VA paperwork
